Children in the Library

Children 8 and under must be supervised by a parent, legal guardian or caregiver over the age of 14 at all times while on the library property. The staff may ask that disruptive children be removed from the library if unacceptable behavior is not corrected.

Minors age 9 and older visiting the library without a parent or guardian are expected to exhibit proper behavior at all times while on library property. A parent or guardian will be notified of unacceptable behavior and may be required to be present on future library visits.

Tutors are welcome to use the library facility and library services. A parent or guardian must remain with students meeting a tutor at the library, regardless of the student's age, until the tutor arrives; and needs to be present at the end of the tutoring session. Tutors must remain with the student until a parent or guardian arrives to pick them up.
