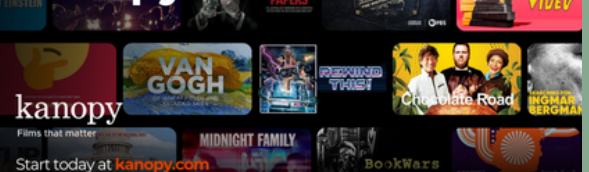
EYES OF THE WILD

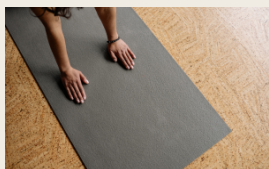


MEDITATION

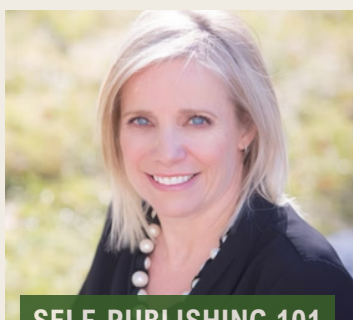
