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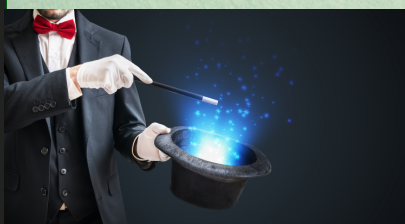
## TRAVEL TO THAILAND THROUGH FLAVOR

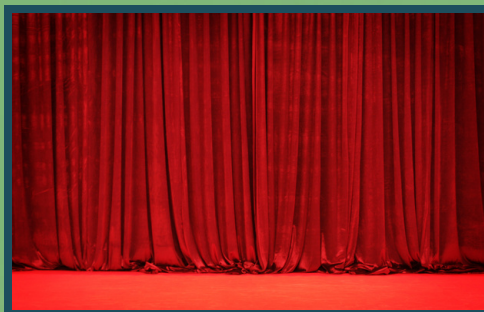

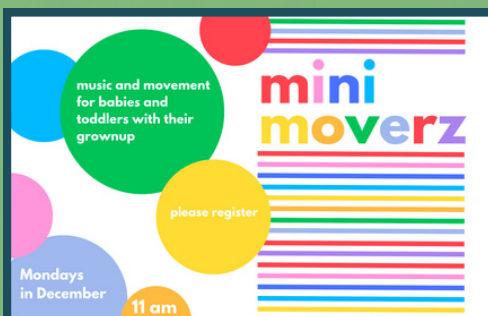

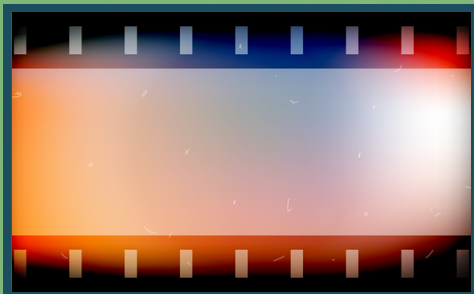


## WIGGLE & GIGGLE WITH MISS BEE
